Class Corner – Year 2

This term, Year 2 have been very busy with lots of exciting learning across the curriculum! In English, we have begun exploring *non-chronological reports* about rainforest animals. We started by creating beautiful pastel drawings of poisonous dart frogs. We have since been learning about the key features of non-chronological reports and have started researching facts for our own reports on animals such as sloths, macaws and jaguars. In Maths, we have been focusing on data. The children have enjoyed creating tally charts and pictograms, as well as interpreting the information they show. We have now moved on to *position and direction*, where we are learning to use the correct mathematical vocabulary confidently.

In Science, we have been sorting and classifying objects as living, non-living or never alive. We will also be identifying different plants and animals and learning about the habitats in which they live.

We have also enjoyed our second session of It's Catching, developing our throwing and catching skills. Additionally, we have started preparing for Sports Day, with a focus on improving our running skills and teamwork.

On Friday, we had a fantastic Careers Day, where we enjoyed hearing from a range of visitors about their different jobs and the skills they use in their roles.
