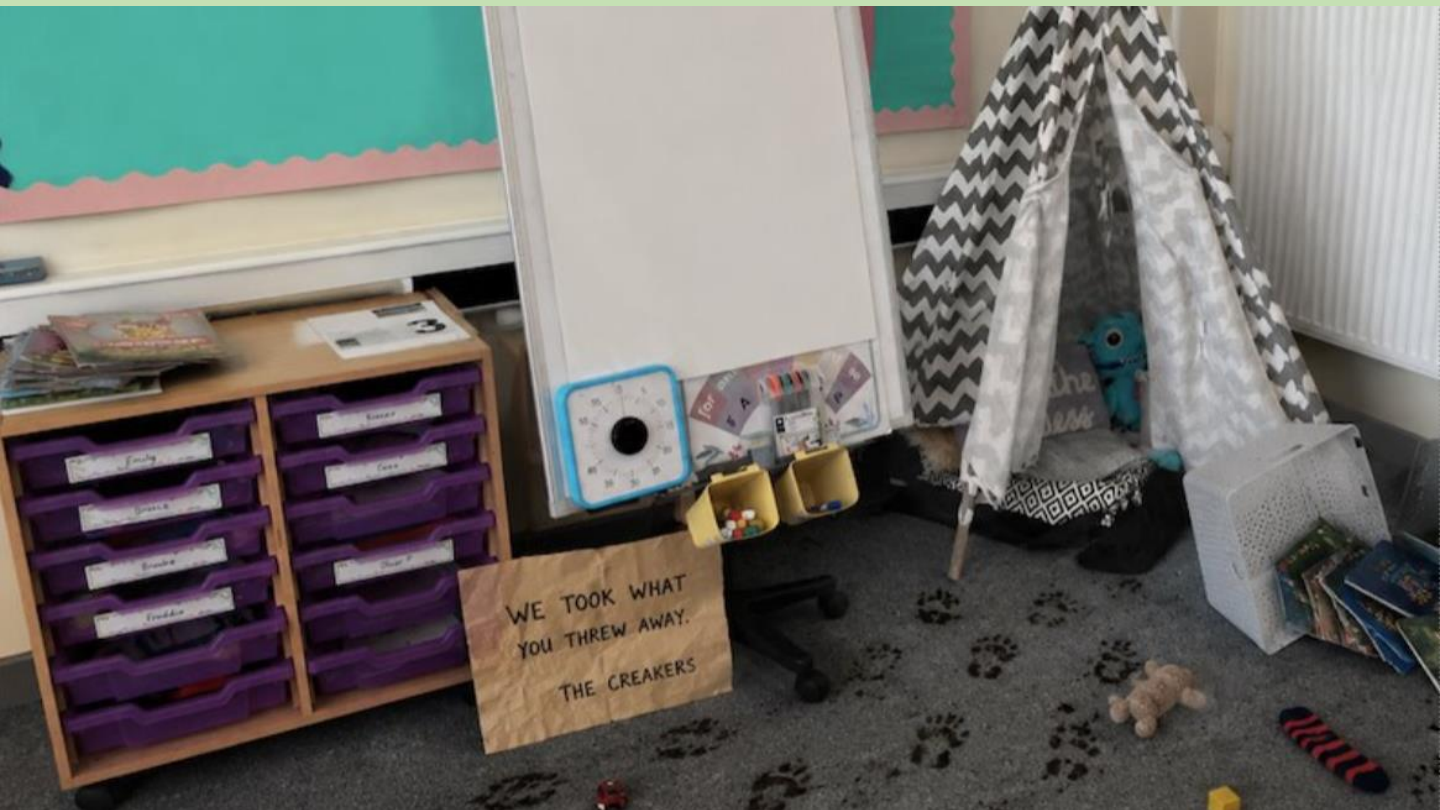
This term, the children have also taken part in Pedestrian Skills Training, developing their awareness of road safety and learning how to stay safe when out and about in our local community.
